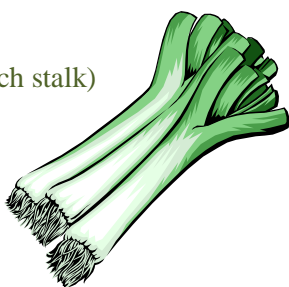

- 1: Beetroot, 3 round (top trimmed to 3 inches)
- 2: Leek – Pot 6 inches to tight button
- 3: Leek - 2 Blanched
- 4: Onion – 3 (dressed)
- 5: Onion - 3 As grown – washed root
- 6: Cabbage - 1 Green (with 3 inch stalk)
- 7: Carrots - 2 long (top trimmed to 3 inch stalk)
- 8: Carrots - 2 stump rooted (top trimmed to 3 inch stalk)
- 9: Potatoes - 3 kidney
- 10: Potatoes - 3 round
- 11: Shallots - 6
- 12: Turnip - 1 top trimmed to 3 inches
- 13: Cucumber - 1 inch stalk
- 14: Marrow – Maximum size 16 inches
- 15: Runner Beans - 6
- 16: French Beans - 6
- 17: Tomatoes - 6
- 18: Tomatoes – 6 small fruited
- 19: Parsnips - 2 (top trimmed to 3 inches)
- 20: Peppers – Sweet x 3
- 21: Sweetcorn– Husk Intact
- 22 Veg x 1- Not included in numbers 1 to 21 above

- 1: Arrangement of 5 Flowers (No foliage)
